

**DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS ACT 1976**

**LICENSING CONDITIONS**

**CONDITIONS SUBJECT TO WHICH THE ABOVE LICENCE IS GRANTED**

1. While any animal is being kept under the authority of the Licence:-
  - i) The animal shall be kept by no person other than the person or persons specified in the licence;
  - ii) The animal shall normally be held at such premises as are specified in the licence;
  - iii) The animal shall not be moved from those premises (except in the following circumstances, namely: Veterinary Treatment Transported in a zoo built carrying box);
  - iv) The person to whom the Licence is granted shall hold a current insurance policy, which insures him, and any other person entitled to keep the animal under the authority of the Licence against liability for any damage, which may be caused by the animal, the terms of such policy being satisfactory in the opinion of the Local Authority.
1. The species and number of animals of each species that may be kept under the authority of the Licence shall be restricted to those specified in the Schedule of the licence.
2. The person to whom the Licence is granted shall at all reasonable times make available a copy of the Licence to any person entitled to keep any animal under the authority of the Licence.
3. Caging shall be of heavy gauge mesh.
4. A concrete foundation of 10" depth and 9" width as minimum.
5. Entry shall be by two independently locking doors.
6. Food storage and preparation area shall have cleansable surfaces, be hygienic and vermin proof. The fridge freezer for storage of food shall be maintained properly.
7. Faecal material must be removed daily.
8. Clean water shall always be available.
9. The animal must be supplied with adequate and suitable food, drink and bedding material and be visited at suitable intervals.

10. While any animal concerned is at the premises where it will normally be held, its accommodation is such that it can take adequate exercise.
11. An impervious liner (e.g. metal sheeting) to minimise cross infection between the two species sleeping area.
12. Common double gate entrance to both pens to be padlocked at all times when attendant not working in the pens.
13. Structural separation of kitchen area from remainder of building.
14. Waste food to be stored in vermin proof building/areas.
15. All reasonable precautions must be taken to prevent infestation by vermin or other pests.
16. All reasonable precautions will be taken at such times to prevent and control the spread of infectious diseases.
17. Appropriate steps will at all such times be taken for the protection of any animal concerned in case of fire or other emergency.
18. The services of a qualified veterinary officer must be obtained to treat cases of infectious or contagious disease.
19. A notice must be displayed in a prominent position outside the premises, stating the name, address and telephone number of the licensee or other person, and instructing as to action in case of fire.
20. Isolation facilities - separate accommodation must be provided for isolation of animals suffering from infectious/contagious disease.
